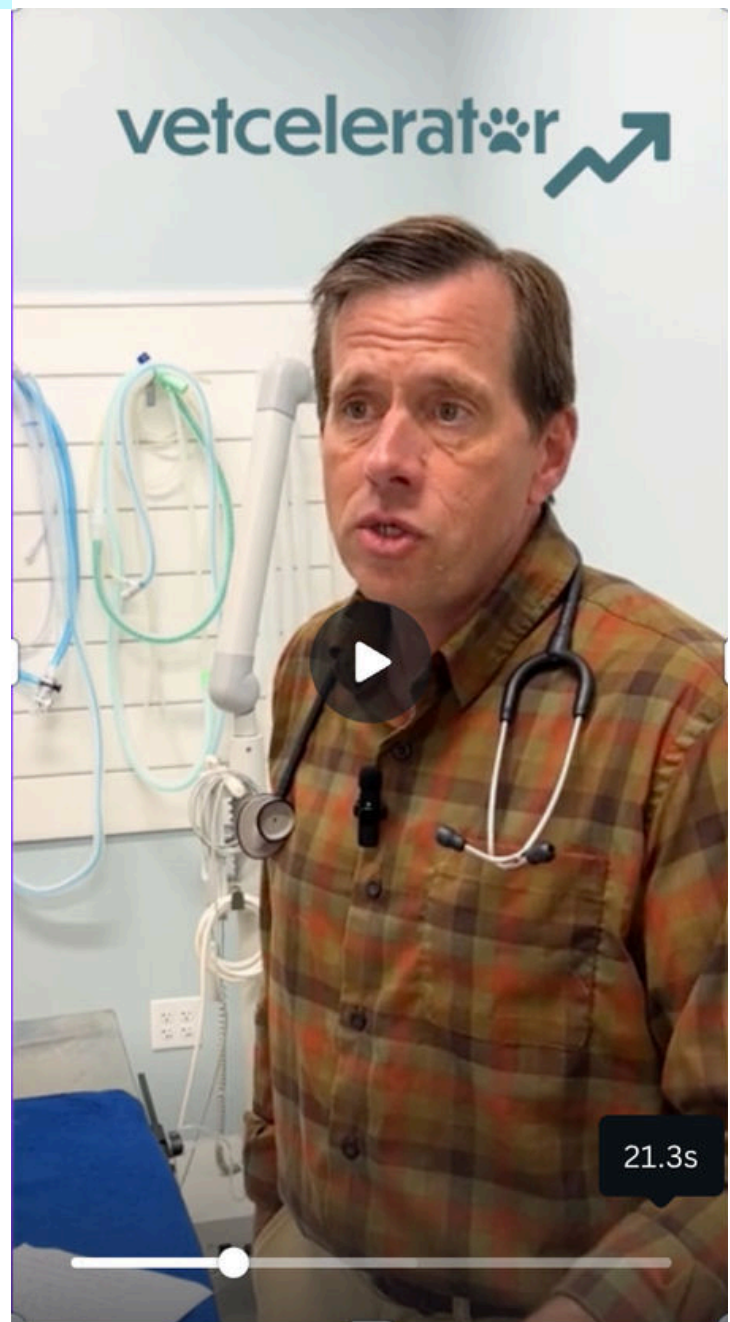
THE CHALLENGE: NAVIGATING THE COMPLEXITIES OF STARTING A NEW PRACTICE

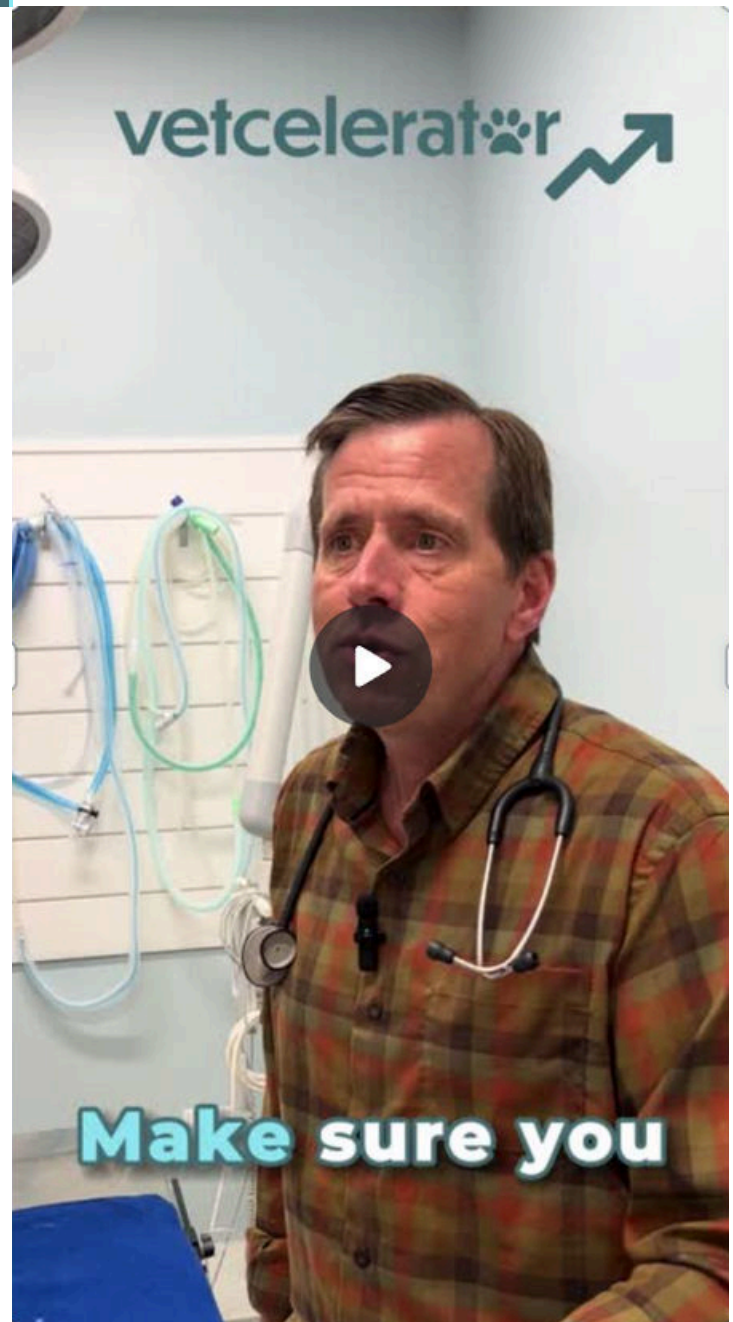
FINDING YOUR WHY AND YOUR JOY
